Who is she?

- She is a woman of substance who functions in the office of "a wife," "a mother" and "a minister" (priest), effortlessly.
- As a "wife", she has specific assignments to her husband.
- As a "mother", she has specific assignments to her household and the household of God.
- As a "minister" (priest), she never ceases to advance the kingdom wherever she finds herself (for example, in her household, the house of God, etc.).



Unveiling the Mysteries of the Proverbs 31.

- Proverbs 31 is a mother's legacy to her son. Which has now become her son's legacy to us.
- Mothers, value the role of "teaching" your children the Word of God. It makes a difference.
- Teach them the complete counsel of God and teach them according to purpose.
- Proverbs 31:1-9, King Lemuel's mother taught him on 3 subject matters;
 - -Women (vs 2-3) -Wine (vs 4-7) -Justice (vs 8-9)

- She lays much emphasis on "women" again from vs 10-31. According to these verses, a woman has potential to function as a "wife", "mother" and "minister" (priest).



- She is fruitful. She bares children (biological, spiritual children).
- She is a (balanced) teacher of the word (vs 1).
- She advises and cautions her child(ren) (vs 3-9 on women, wine, justice).
- She trains them in their calling (assignment). Lemuel was advised as king, not as ordinary.
- She equips the child(ren) with core values.
- She provides specific criteria for the things to look out for in a woman (Proverbs 31:10-31).



Proverbs 31:10 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

¹⁰ A capable, intelligent, *and* virtuous woman—who is he who can find her? She is far more precious than jewels *and* her value is far above rubies *or* pearls.

- -She understands her value in Christ and does not seek to obtain value from anything and validation from anyone.
- She is a woman of wisdom (insight).
- -She is a type of Proverbs 18:22 woman; Who can find her? A husband! A man of substance; She is pursued. She does not pursue; The one who finds her obtains favor from the Lord.

*Wife, mother, and minister.



Proverbs 31:11-12 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

¹¹ The heart of <u>her husband</u> trusts in her confidently *and* relies on and believes in her securely, so that he has no lack of [honest] gain or need of [dishonest] spoil.

- She is trustworthy and reliable.
- She brings value, not dishonest spoil.

12 She comforts, encourages, and does him only good as long as there is life within her.



Proverbs 31:13 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

¹³ She seeks out wool and flax and works with willing hands [to develop it].

- She is industrious
- She works relentlessly to minister to both the children of God and the gentiles, through teaching the word and evangelism.





Proverbs 31:14 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

¹⁴ She is like the merchant ships loaded with foodstuffs; she brings her household's food from a far [country].

- She goes the extra mile
- to obtain knowledge (physical and spiritual).
- apply the wisdom in her home in every area.



Proverbs 31:15 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

¹⁵ She rises while it is yet night and gets [spiritual] food for her household and assigns her maids their tasks.

- She cares about the spiritual health of her household
- She delegates with wisdom.
- Her services to God precede her services to man.



Proverbs 31:16 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

¹⁶ She considers a [new] field before she buys *or* accepts it [expanding prudently and not courting neglect of her present duties by assuming other duties]; with her savings [of time and strength] she plants fruitful vines in her vineyard.

- She is very thoughtful (reasonable, sensible, etc.)
- She does not "rob Peter to pay Paul".
- She uses her time wisely.
- She invests her strength resources wisely (on important things).
- She is productive (fruitful).



Proverbs 31:17 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

¹⁷ She girds herself with strength [spiritual, mental, and physical fitness for her God-given task] and makes her arms strong *and* firm.

- She strengthens herself spiritually, mentally and through physical fitness.
- She lives a balanced and healthy spiritual life as she fulfills purpose.
- She strengthens her weakness.



Proverbs 31:18 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

¹⁸ She tastes *and* sees that her gain from work [with and for God] is good; her lamp goes not out, but it burns on continually through the night [of trouble, privation, or sorrow, warning away fear, doubt, and distrust].

- She evaluates her work (profit) **for/with** God and makes necessary adjustments.
- In difficult seasons, she keeps the lamp of God burning. She is an overcomer. She is not overcome.



Proverbs 31:19 (AMPC)

¹⁹ She lays her hands to the spindle, and her hands hold the distaff.

Proverbs 31:20 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

²⁰ She opens her hand to the poor, yes, she reaches out her filled hands to the needy [whether in body, mind, or spirit].

- *Difference between poor and needy
- Needy in the economical sense means so poor as to be unable to obtain the necessities of life food, clothing, shelter, etc.
- If you are needy, then you are poor. But if you are poor, state welfare and private charity may provide enough to make sure you are not needy.
- She is rich therefore, able to help the poor, without hesitation.
- She is balanced in body, mind and spirit, therefore, filled enough to offer her services to help those in need (in the areas of body, mind and spirit).
- She always has something to offer. No one encounters her and leaves the same.



Proverbs 31:21 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

²¹ She fears not the snow for her family, for all her household are doubly clothed in scarlet.

- She is proactive in her care for the family, physically and spiritually.
- She is wise, so she does not allow seasons to take her by surprise.
- She is prudent (sensible)
- Her family is not a victim of changing seasons.



Proverbs 31:22 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

²² She makes for herself coverlets, cushions, *and* rugs of tapestry. Her clothing is of linen, pure *and* fine, and of purple [such as that of which the clothing of the <u>priests</u> and the hallowed cloths of the temple were made].

She understands and works from a place of "grace" not the "law". She is clothed in the anointing and royalty.

Ezekiel 44:15-18 (NIV)

¹⁵ "However, the sons of Zadok, of the tribe of Levi, continued as my priests in the Temple when Israel abandoned me for idols. These men shall be my ministers; they shall stand before me to offer the fat and blood of the sacrifices," says the Lord God.

- ¹⁶ "They shall enter my sanctuary and come to my Table to minister to me; they shall fulfill my requirements.
- ¹⁷ "They must <u>wear only linen clothing</u> when they enter the passageway to the inner court, for they <u>must wear no wool</u> while on duty in the inner court or in the Temple.
- ¹⁸ They must wear linen turbans and linen trousers; they must not wear anything that would cause them to perspire.
- She is very creative; She is a woman of style and standard/taste; She dresses as royalty; Her clothing reflects that she belongs to a divine class (priests and ministers). Therefore, she dresses like she would like to be addressed.

Proverbs 31:23 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

AMPC

²³ Her <u>husband</u> is known in the [city's] gates, when he sits among the elders of the land.

MSG

²³ Her <u>husband</u> is greatly respected when he deliberates with the city fathers.

- She is a respectful wife. Thereby, fulfilling her purpose (Ephesians 5:33b).
- She speaks well of him in public and sets the precedence for others to do likewise.
- She helps her husband live his full potential by respecting him.





Proverbs 31:24 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

²⁴ She makes fine linen garments *and* leads others to buy them; she delivers to the merchants girdles [or sashes that free one up for service].

- She walks in the anointing and leads others to buy into it. By so doing, she frees people up for service.
- She is creative; She is hardworking; She is a servant; She is lucrative.

*Minister



Proverbs 31:25 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

Strength and dignity are her clothing *and* her position is strong and secure; she rejoices over the future [the latter day or time to come, knowing that she and her family are in readiness for it]!

- Isaiah 30:15 ...in quietness and confidence is her strength. She wears strength and honor as clothing. She is a woman of character and substance; She is not a pushover.
- She is proactive and always in a state of readiness; She is reliable/dependable; She moves circumspectly.



Proverbs 31:26 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

²⁶ She opens her mouth in skillful and godly Wisdom, and on her tongue is the law of kindness [giving counsel and instruction].

- She is not flippant; does not speak vain words or carelessly.
- She is a woman of substance and it is reflective in her words.
- She gives both counsel (advise) and instruction (direction). Therefore, there is order in her world.

Proverbs 31:27 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

AMPC

²⁷ She looks well to how things go in her household, and the bread of idleness (gossip, discontent, and self-pity) she will not eat.

MSG

• She keeps an eye on everyone in her household, and keeps them all busy and productive.



Proverbs 31:28-29 (AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

- ²⁸ Her <u>children rise up</u> and call her blessed (happy, fortunate, and to be envied); and <u>her husband boasts of *and* praises her, [saying],</u>
- ²⁹ Many daughters have done virtuously, nobly, *and* well [with the strength of character that is steadfast in goodness], but you excel them all.





Proverbs 31:30-31(AMPC)

Wife, Mother, or Minister?

³⁰ Charm *and* grace are deceptive, and beauty is vain [because it is not lasting], but a woman who reverently *and* worshipfully fears the Lord, she shall be praised!

AMPC

³¹ Give her of the fruit of her hands, and let her own works praise her in the gates [of the city]!

MSG

³¹Give her everything she deserves! Festoon her life with praises!
