Psalm 110:3 NLT

<sup>3</sup> When you go to war, your people will serve you willingly. You are arrayed in holy garments, and your strength will be renewed each day like the morning dew.



### **Bless The Lord God My Satisfier**

Psalm 103:1-5 AMPC

<sup>1</sup>Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul; and all that is [deepest] within me, bless His holy name!

- <sup>2</sup> Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul, and forget not [one of] all His benefits—
- <sup>3</sup> Who forgives [every one of] all your iniquities, Who heals [each one of] all your diseases,

<sup>4</sup> Who redeems your life from the pit *and* corruption, Who beautifies, dignifies, *and* crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercy;

<sup>5</sup> Who satisfies your mouth [your necessity and desire at your personal age and situation] with good so that your youth, renewed, is like the eagle's [strong, overcoming, soaring]!





- Acts 1:4-6 NKJV
- <sup>4</sup> And being assembled together with *them*, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the **Promise of the Father**, "which," *He said*, "you have heard from Me;
- <sup>5</sup> for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."
- <sup>6</sup> Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?"





- Acts 1:7-8 NKJV
- <sup>7</sup> And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority.
- <sup>8</sup> But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."





Hebrews 4:7-9 NLT

<sup>7</sup> So God set another time for entering his rest, and that time is today. God announced this through David much later in the words already quoted:

"Today when you hear his voice, don't harden your hearts."

<sup>8</sup> Now if Joshua had succeeded in giving them this rest, God would not have spoken about another day of rest still to come.

<sup>9</sup> So there is a special rest still waiting for the people of God.





Isaiah 6:5,8 AMPC

<sup>5</sup> Then said I, Woe is me! For I am undone and ruined, because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!

<sup>6</sup> Then flew one of the seraphim [heavenly beings] to me, having a live coal in his hand which he had taken with tongs from off the altar;

<sup>7</sup> And with it he touched my mouth and said, Behold, this has touched your lips; your iniquity and guilt are taken away, and your sin is completely atoned for and forgiven.

<sup>8</sup> Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send? And who will go for Us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.

- Isaiah was made aware of his own unworthiness
- Rest: Cease from doing works as basis for our righteousness
- The Lord wants willing and enthusiastic volunteers who will say, "Here I am, send me!"

Genesis 21:15-18 NIV

<sup>15</sup> When the water in the skin was gone, she put the boy under one of the bushes.

<sup>16</sup> Then she went off and sat down about a bowshot away, for she thought, "I cannot watch the boy die." And as she sat there, she began to sob.

<sup>17</sup> God heard the boy crying, and the angel of God called to Hagar from heaven and said to her, "What is the matter, Hagar? Do not be afraid; God has heard the boy crying as he lies there.

<sup>18</sup> Lift the boy up and take him by the hand, for <mark>I will make him into a great nation."</mark>

<sup>37</sup> Peter's words pierced their hearts, and they said to him and to the other apostles, "Brothers, what should we do?"

#### Romans 8:26-27 AMPC

<sup>26</sup> So too the [Holy] Spirit comes to our aid *and* bears us up in our weakness; for we do not know what prayer to offer *nor* how to offer it worthily as we ought, but the Spirit Himself goes to meet our supplication *and* pleads in our behalf with unspeakable yearnings *and* groanings too deep for utterance.

<sup>27</sup> And He Who searches the hearts of men knows what is in the mind of the [Holy] Spirit [what His intent is], because the Spirit intercedes *and* pleads [before God] in behalf of the saints according to *and* in harmony with God's will.





Holy Spirit Change The Way I Speak! – Prayer Points

- May unbelievers understand when you speak in tongues (1 Cor 14:22)
- Ask for the ministry gift of tongues for the exhortation of the brethren (1 Cor 12:10)
- Ask for the ministry gift of interpretation of tongues
- Pray in the power of the Holy Spirit to edify the brethren (Jude 20)
- May your words not fall to the ground because whatever you bind/loose on earth shall have been bound/loosed in heaven (Matt 18:18)

Isaiah 60:1-3,5 NKJV

<sup>1</sup>Arise, <mark>shine</mark>; For your light has come! And the <mark>glory of</mark> the LORD is risen upon you.

<sup>2</sup> For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people; But the LORD will arise over you, And His glory will be seen upon you.

<sup>3</sup> The Gentiles shall come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising.

<sup>5</sup> Then you shall see and become radiant, And your heart shall swell with joy; Because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to you, The wealth of the Gentiles shall come to you.





#### Acts 3:1-3 NLT

<sup>1</sup>Peter and John went to the Temple one afternoon to take part in the three o'clock prayer service.

<sup>2</sup> As they approached the Temple, a man lame from birth was being carried in. Each day he was put beside the Temple gate, the one called the Beautiful Gate, so he could beg from the people going into the Temple.

<sup>3</sup> When <mark>he saw </mark>Peter and John about to enter, <mark>he asked </mark> them for some money.





- Acts 3:4-7 NLT
- <sup>4</sup> Peter and John <mark>looked at him intently</mark>, and Peter said, "Look at us!"
- <sup>5</sup> The lame man looked at them eagerly, expecting some money.
- <sup>6</sup> But Peter said, "I don't have any silver or gold for you. But I'll give you what I have. In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, get up and walk!"
- <sup>7</sup> Then Peter took the lame man by the right hand and helped him up. And as he did, the man's feet and ankles were instantly healed and strengthened.





Matthew 17:1-3,5 NIV

<sup>1</sup>After six days Jesus took with him Peter, James and John the brother of James, and led them up a high mountain by themselves.

<sup>2</sup> There he was <mark>transfigured</mark> before them. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as the light.

<sup>3</sup> Just then there appeared before them Moses and Elijah, talking with Jesus.

<sup>5</sup> While he was still speaking, a bright cloud covered them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!"





Exodus 34:29 NIV

<sup>29</sup> When Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the covenant law in his hands, he was not aware that his face was radiant because he had spoken with the LORD.

Psalm 34:5 NIV

<sup>5</sup> Those who look to him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame.

2 Corinthians 3:18 AMPC

<sup>18</sup> And all of us, as with unveiled face, [because we] continued to behold [in the Word of God] as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are constantly being transfigured into His very own image in ever increasing splendor and from one degree of glory to another; [for this comes] from the Lord [Who is] the Spirit.

<sup>20</sup> Your sun shall no longer go down, Nor shall your moon withdraw itself; For the LORD will be your everlasting light, And the days of your mourning shall be ended.





Holy Spirit Make My Appearance Synonymous With Redemptive Solutions! – Prayer Points

- John 12:45 ESV <sup>45</sup> And whoever sees me sees him who sent me.
- Zechariah 12:10 KJV ... and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced ...
- Numbers 21:9 AMPC ... when he looked to the serpent of bronze [attentively, expectantly, with a steady and absorbing gaze], he lived.
- 2 Kings 3:14 KJV <sup>14</sup> And Elisha said, ... were it not that I regard the presence of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah, I would not look toward thee, nor see thee.
- Acts 5:15b KJV that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.

#### Judges 6:11,14-16 NKJV

<sup>11</sup>Now the Angel of the LORD came and sat under the terebinth tree which *was* in Ophrah, which *belonged* to Joash the Abiezrite, while his son Gideon threshed wheat in the winepress, **in order to hide** *it* from the Midianites.

<sup>14</sup> Then the LORD turned to him and said, "Go in this might of yours, and you shall save Israel from the hand of the Midianites. Have I not sent you?"

<sup>15</sup> So he said to Him, "O my Lord, how can I save Israel? Indeed my clan *is* the weakest in Manasseh, and I *am* the least in my father's house."

<sup>16</sup> And the LORD said to him, "Surely I will be with you, and you shall defeat the Midianites as one man."

Exodus 3:10-12 NKJV

<sup>10</sup> Come now, therefore, and <mark>I will send you to Pharaoh</mark> that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt."

<sup>11</sup> But Moses said to God, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?"

<sup>12</sup> So He said, "I will certainly be with you. And this *shall be* a sign to you that I have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain."





Act 4:8-10 NLT

<sup>8</sup>Then Peter, <mark>filled with the Holy Spirit</mark>, said to them, "Rulers and elders of our people,

<sup>9</sup> are we being questioned today because we've done a good deed for a crippled man? Do you want to know how he was healed?

<sup>10</sup> Let me clearly state to all of you and to all the people of Israel that he was **healed by the powerful name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene,** the man you crucified but whom God raised from the dead.





Act 4:11,13-14 NLT

<sup>11</sup> For Jesus is the one referred to in the Scriptures, where it says, **'The stone that you builders rejected has** now become the cornerstone.'

<sup>13</sup> The members of the council were amazed when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, for they could see that they were ordinary men with no special training in the Scriptures. They also recognized them as men who had been with Jesus.

<sup>14</sup> But since the could see the man who had been healed standing right there among them, there was nothing the council could say.

Act 4:16,18-20 NLT

<sup>16</sup> "What should we do with these men?" they asked each other. "We can't deny that they have performed a miraculous sign, and everybody in Jerusalem knows about it.

<sup>18</sup> So they called the apostles back in and commanded them never again to speak or teach in the name of Jesus.

<sup>19</sup> But Peter and John replied, <mark>"Do you think God wants us</mark> to obey you rather than him?

<sup>20</sup> We cannot stop telling about everything we have seen and heard."





Act 4:29-31 NLT

<sup>29</sup> And now, O Lord, hear their threats, and give us, your servants, great boldness in preaching your word.

<sup>30</sup> Stretch out your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus."

<sup>31</sup> After this prayer, the meeting place shook, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit. Then they preached the word of God with boldness.





Holy Spirit Change My Behavior To Reflect God's Presence With Me! – Prayer Points

- Surrender/Dependence upon Christ and the power of the Holy Spirit (Colossians 2:8)
- Pray for Christ's divine power and nature to be our portion (2 Peter 1:3-4)
- Make every effort to possess in increasing measure faith, goodness, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, mutual affection, love (2 Peter 1:5-8)
- 2 Timothy 1:7 KJV <sup>7</sup> For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Psalm 23 KJV

<sup>1</sup>The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

<sup>2</sup> He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.

<sup>3</sup> He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

<sup>4</sup>Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, <mark>I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.</mark>

<sup>5</sup> Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

<sup>6</sup> Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.





Exodus 9:23-26 NLT

<sup>23</sup> So Moses lifted his staff toward the sky, and the LORD sent thunder and hail, and lightning flashed toward the earth. The LORD sent a tremendous hailstorm against all the land of Egypt.

<sup>24</sup> Never in all the history of Egypt had there been a storm like that, with such devastating hail and continuous lightning.

<sup>25</sup> It left all of Egypt in ruins. The hail struck down everything in the open field—people, animals, and plants alike. Even the trees were destroyed.

<sup>26</sup> The only place without hail was the region of Goshen, where the people of Israel lived.





Acts 5:1-5 TLB

<sup>1</sup>But there was a man named Ananias (with his wife Sapphira) who sold some property

<sup>2</sup> and brought only part of the money, claiming it was the full price. (His wife had agreed to this deception.)

<sup>3</sup> But Peter said, "Ananias, Satan has filled your heart. When you claimed this was the full price, <mark>you were lying to the Holy Spirit</mark>.

<sup>4</sup>The property was yours to sell or not, as you wished. And after selling it, it was yours to decide how much to give. How could you do a thing like this? You weren't lying to us, but to God."

<sup>5</sup> As soon as Ananias heard these words, he fell to the floor, dead! Everyone was terrified,





Acts 5:12, 17-20, 32 TLB

<sup>12</sup> Meanwhile, the apostles were meeting regularly at the Temple in the area known as Solomon's Hall, and they did many remarkable miracles among the people.

<sup>17</sup> The High Priest and his relatives and friends among the Sadducees **reacted with violent jealousy** 

<sup>18</sup> and arrested the apostles, and put them in the public jail.

<sup>19</sup> But <mark>an angel of the Lord</mark> came at night, <mark>opened the gates of the jail and brought them out</mark>. Then he told them,

<sup>20</sup> "Go over to the Temple and preach about this Life!"

<sup>32</sup> And we are witnesses of these things and so is the Holy Spirit, who is given by God to all who obey him."





#### John 15:15-16, 26-27 NKJV

<sup>15</sup> No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.

<sup>16</sup> You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain, that what what ever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.

<sup>26</sup> "But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me.

<sup>27</sup> And <mark>you also will bear witness</mark>, because you have been with Me from the beginning.





### Holy Spirit Change My Experiences Going Forward! – Prayer Points

- I am defined by the scars of Jesus and not by my own scars
- I will amount to much because Jesus does not condemn me
- I am good enough to experience overflows because Christ fed multitudes and there were leftovers
- I will function in divine health because no one encountered Christ with any sickness and was not healed
- My enemies will live to see me dine at the table The Lord has prepared for me
- May the coin of sufficient value (Matthew 17:27) always be with me
- I am loved, forgiven, favored, acknowledged, accepted, etc.
