The 4th Watch

- The cool wind of the 4th watch is what causes the dew to be collected.
- The cool wind condenses the cloud which leads to rain, snow, etc.

Understanding dew water formation

Condensation Process

- Dew water formation occurs through the process of condensation.
- During the day, the sun heats the air, causing water to evaporate from various sources such as rivers, lakes, and plants.
- The evaporated water turns into water vapor and mixes with the air, creating humidity.

Google excerpt.

Humidity and Temperature

- As evening approaches, temperatures drop, and the air loses its ability to hold as much water vapor.
- Higher humidity levels lead to more moisture in the air, which increases the likelihood of dew formation when temperatures drop.
- When the temperature of an object, such as a plant leaf or a car window, falls below the dew point, the excess water vapor in the air condenses into water droplets on the surface of the object. This is how dew forms.

Humidity and Temperature

- Understanding the correlation between air, dew, heat, sun, and humidity is essential for efficient dew collection.
- By leveraging the natural processes of condensation and temperature fluctuations, individuals can harvest and make use of this valuable water source.

The Account of Creation

¹ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

² The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters.

⁶ Then God said, “Let there be a space between the waters, to separate the waters of the heavens from the waters of the earth.”

⁷ And that is what happened. God made this space to separate the waters of the earth from the waters of the heavens.

⁸ God called the space “sky.” And evening passed and morning came, marking the second day.

- Before God separated the heavens and earth, they were both merged (by water).
- Water already existed from creation. At no point was it recorded that God “created water”.
- It is typically known that water comes from the clouds in the “sky”.

- The Spirit and water have a great relationship.

We are told that “the Spirit hovered upon the waters”.

Hovered is the Hebrew word “rachaph” which means “relax” in English.

In other words, the Spirit feels comfortable with water.

Genesis 1:1-2 (NIV) - The Beginning

¹ In the beginning God created the heavens (**shamayim**) and the earth (**erets**).

The Hebrew word for sky is **shamayim**.

Hebrew tradition tells us that this word is a construct of the Hebrew words **esh** (fire) and **mayim** (water).

It's a lovely image - **fire and water** combining to form the heavens.

² Now the earth (**erets**) was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit (**ruach - breath, wind, spirit**) of God was hovering (**rachaph - relax**) over the waters (**mayim**).

DWELLING PLACES

Content / Atmosphere of the dwelling place of demons.

An unclean spirit returns

Matthew 12

⁴³ “When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none.

⁴⁴ Then he says, ‘I will return to my house from which I came.’ and when he comes, he finds *it* empty, swept, and put in order.

⁴⁵ Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last *state* of that man is worse than the first. So shall it also be with this wicked generation.”

Content / Atmosphere of the dwelling place of demons.

- Why was a dry place the first choice for habitation?
 - From dryness to dryness and back to dryness.
-

The dry places in this verse is referring to a location. However, if we apply the principle of the text, it equally refers to “a dry life.”

- Dehydration attracts demons.
- A showerless body attracts demons.
- A spiritual life void of Holy Spirit activities, attracts demonic activities.

Content / Atmosphere of the dwelling place of demons.

- The body of depressed people are breeding grounds for demonic habitation and activities.

Why?

Most do not take showers, eat or drink well. As a result, they deprive their bodies of water (internally and externally).

• Ephesians 5:25-26 (NKJV)

²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave himself for her,

²⁶ That he might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,

• **Hebrews 10:22 (NKJV)**

- The dwelling place of God contains water.
- Therefore, God likes watery(fluid) environments. Why?
- Water is the only element that existed before God spoke anything into being.
- Creation came out of water.

We are created in the image of God, therefore, ...

- 70% of our body is water.
- We cannot go without water for more than 3days.
[Water is what holds the earth (you are I) together.
- However, we can go without food for 21days.

Question

- Why do you think God likes water so much?

According to the law of 1st mention...

- The Spirit was relaxing over the waters.

Water is a means by which God transmits His voice from the heaven to the earth

A] Psalm 29:3-4 (NIV)

The voice of the Lord is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the Lord thunders over the mighty waters.

The voice of the lord is powerful; the voice of the Lord is majestic.

Water is a means by which God transmits His voice from the heaven to the earth

B] Revelation 14:2 (KJV)

And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps:

The water from heaven is the same as the water on earth

Whenever you drink water, purposefully remind yourself...

- that the Spirit is relaxing on the water you are drinking. Therefore, I am drinking God.
- that the Lord is speaking to you, therefore, be keen to hear and understand what He is communicating through the medium of water.

The water from heaven is the same as the water on earth

Whenever you shower with pure water, purposefully remind yourself...

- that the Spirit is relaxing on the water you shower.
- that the Lord is speaking to you, therefore, be keen to hear and understand what He is communicating through the medium of water.

Taking showers frequently is a spiritual action. Therefore, shower often.

The water from heaven is the same as the water on earth

The spirit moves on water that is why Jesus said the following...

John 7:37-39 (NIV)

On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me **and drink.**"

Whoever believes in me, as scripture has said, **rivers of living water will flow from within them."**

By this He meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.

John 19:34 (KJV)

But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out **blood and water**.

When next you use water to partake in communion, do not see it as mere water.

Discern it as the water that came out of the side of Jesus Christ.

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Water is a means by which God moves Himself.

Water is a transportation means of the presence of God.

Whenever God is upon something, it is for the purpose of transmitting Himself.

E.g. when God wants to transmit Himself into a service, He comes upon His servant.

Psalm 104:2-3 (NLT)

² You are dressed in a robe of light. You stretch out the starry curtain of the heavens;

³ You lay out the rafters of Your home in the rain clouds. You make the clouds Your chariot; You ride upon the wings of the wind.

Water is a means by which God transmits **His presence** from the heaven to the earth.

Isaiah 19:1

KJV

¹ The burden of Egypt. Behold, the LORD rideth upon **a swift cloud**, and shall come into Egypt: and the idols of Egypt shall be moved at **His presence**, and the heart of Egypt shall melt in the midst of it.

NIV - A Prophecy against Egypt

¹ A prophecy against Egypt: see, the LORD rides on **a swift cloud** and is coming to Egypt. The idols of Egypt tremble before Him, and the hearts of the Egyptians melt with fear.

Water is a means by which God transmits **His presence** from the heaven to the earth.

- Cloud is simply water in a mist.

- Dictionary definition of cloud

A visible mass of condensed water vapor floating in the atmosphere, typically high above the ground.

Ecclesiastes 11:3

• If the clouds be full of rain, they empty themselves upon the earth: and if the tree fall toward the south, or toward the north, in the place where the tree falleth, there it shall be.

Through water, God makes people great

Ezekiel 31:1-4 (KJV)

¹ And it came to pass in the eleventh year, in the third month, in the first day of the month, that the Lord of the LORD came unto me, saying,

² Son of man, speak unto Pharaoh King of Egypt, and to his multitude; whom art thou like in thy greatness?

³ Behold, the Assyrian was a cedar in Lebanon with fair branches, and with a shadowing shroud, and of an high stature; and his top was among the thick boughs.

⁴ The waters made him great, the deep set him up on high with her rivers running round about his plants, and sent her little rivers unto all the trees of the field.

Through water, God makes people great

- The journey of greatness begins with life.
- Water ensures that the life within us is preserved.
- Then, through the Holy Spirit we achieve greatness in the Kingdom.

John 7:38-39 (KJV)

³⁸ He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, **out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.**

³⁹ (But this spake he of the spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the holy ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

Makeup your mind to always look at rainfall as the blessings from God's storehouse.

While the rain falls, make declarations, receive the blessings from God's storehouse upon the work of your hands.

Deuteronomy 28:12 (Easy-to-read Version)

The LORD will open **His storehouse where He keeps His rich blessings.** He will send rain at the right time for your land. He will bless everything you do. You will have money to lend to many nations. And you will not need to borrow anything from them.

The circuit of **water** and the circuit of the **Word**

Definition of Circuit

Movement that starts and finishes at the same place.

The circuit of **water** and the circuit of the **Word**

Isaiah 55:10-11

NASB

¹⁰ “For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return there without watering the earth and making it produce and sprout, and providing seed to the sower and bread to the eater;

NKJV


¹¹ So shall my Word be that goes forth from my mouth; it shall not return to me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper *in the thing* for which I sent it.

The circuit of the **Water**

- **Water (in the form of rain and snow) come from above to the earth (making it produce and sprout, and providing seed to the sower and bread to the eater) and goes back up...then repeats the process.**

The circuit of the **Word**

The Word of God (**which comes from God**), returns to God. However, it does not return void (**but it accomplishes what the Lord pleases, and it prospers *in the thing* for which it was sent**).

- 
- The voice of God is transmitted through water.
 - The presence of God is transported through water.
 - Water makes a person great.

Through the dew that comes from heaven, God is doing the following for us...

- God is transmitting His voice (communicating) to us.
- God is transporting His presence to us.
- God is making us great.

- The dew is a messenger with a message from our Father to us.
 - The dew is an indication that the Lord has arrived with a message to deliver.
-

- When the dew dries up, it is an indication that the message has been delivered for the day and records have been taken back to heaven.

- Everything that we require in a day are packaged in the dew.
- The early morning dew (during the fourth watch of the night) is a messenger.
- It comes from above with a message.
- The blessings from God for the day are transported by the dew.
- The presence of God hovers over all of God's creation by the dew.
(Be reminded that the Holy Spirit moves over the water as the blessing upon the dew).

- The dew vaporizes and returns up with the heating of the sun.
- Water is a means by which reports from the earth and about everyone are carried back to the Father (through the activation of the dew).

NB:

The dew never returns to the Father, void.

Deuteronomy 32:2 (NIV)

²Let my teaching fall like rain and my words descend like dew, like showers on new grass, like abundant rain on tender plants.

The dew brings the blessing of the day and, also takes a report back to the Lord.

If a person wants to be blessed for the day, it is wise not to miss the messenger dew.

- Everyday, before you step out, declare that

“all the blessings of the dew are kept in my account and are maintained.”

- Find a way to collect dew early in the morning.
(Fresh dew is very vital for the day).

Use the dew to wipe your face in the morning and declare that

“by this dew I collect all my blessings for the day. My face shines to all my helpers positioned for me in the day.”

Or,

Get water and declare over it as dew. Then, wipe your face and your eyes.

Hebrews 10:19-23 (NKJV)

Hold fast your confession

¹⁹ Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the **holiest by the blood of Jesus,**

²⁰ by a new and living way which he consecrated for us, **through the veil, that is, his flesh,**

²¹ and *having* a high priest over the house of God,

²² let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, **having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.**

Beyond confessions...

- Carry out the prophetic acts consistently with understanding and come back with testimonies.

Remember,

- God himself rides on the water (dew).
- The dew is a message from God to His people.
- The drying up of the dew is an indication that His message (blessings) for the day have been delivered and records from His people have been collected and delivered to Him.

- Use the dew to touch your tongue.

Deuteronomy 32:2 (KJV)

My doctrine shall drop as the rain, **my speech shall distil as the dew**, as the small rain upon the tender herb, and as the showers upon the grass:

You want that your speech for that day will be His speech.

(See Isaiah 50:4 (NIV))

- Use the dew to touch your ears and declare.

Use dew to open your ears because the ears are the transmission medium of his voice.

Use the dew to anoint the back of your ears

(The awaking of my ears for the day that I may hear Your voice. That I may have clarity of what You are saying to me for the day).

Isaiah 50:4 (NIV)

⁴ The sovereign LORD has given me a well-instructed tongue, to know the word that sustains the weary. He wakens me morning by morning, wakens my ear to listen like one being instructed.

- Step on the dew and declare.

If you want prosperity in your finances, use the morning dew; step on it.
Do so before you go for a major interview; to close a major contract.
