Discerning the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ

The Body of Jesus Christ

- Isaiah 53:4 (AMPC)

⁴ Surely He has borne our <u>griefs</u> (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and carried our <u>sorrows</u> *and* pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy].

Borne - nasa or nasah (in Hebrew), means to lift, carry, take.

Grief - choli (in Hebrew), means sickness.



The Body of Jesus Christ

- Mark 15:21-23 (NKJV)
- ²¹ A certain man from Cyrene, Simon, the father of Alexander and Rufus, was passing by on his way in from the country, and they forced him to carry the cross.
- ²²They brought Jesus to the place called Golgotha (which means "the place of the skull").
- ²³ Then they offered him wine mixed with myrrh, but he did not take it.

- Mark 15:21-23 (MSG)
- There was a man walking by, coming from work, Simon from Cyrene, the father of Alexander and Rufus. They made him carry Jesus' cross.
- ²²The soldiers brought Jesus to Golgotha, meaning "Skull Hill."
- ²³ They offered him a mild painkiller (wine mixed with myrrh), but he wouldn't take it.
