

- <sup>23</sup> until finally he said, "Both of you say this live baby is yours.
- <sup>24</sup> Someone bring me a sword." A sword was brought, and Solomon ordered,
- <sup>25</sup> "Cut the baby in half! That way each of you can have part of him."
- <sup>26</sup> "Please don't kill my son," the baby's mother screamed. "Your Majesty, I love him very much, but give him to her. Just don't kill him." The other woman shouted, "Go ahead and cut him in half. Then neither of us will have the baby."
- <sup>27</sup> Solomon said, "Don't kill the baby." Then he pointed to the first woman, "She is his real mother. Give the baby to her."
