Reconnect with The Word – WIIFM?

- ▶ How does it benefit me now and in the future?
- ▶ Deuteronomy 8:2-3 NKJV

² And you shall remember that the LORD your God led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you *and* test you, to know what *was* in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

³ So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every *word* that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.

Reconnect with The Word – WIIFM, Your First Love

- ▶ John 1:1 KJV ¹In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God.**
- ▶ 1 John 4:19 KJV ¹⁹We love him, because **he first loved us.**
- ▶ Romans 5:8 KJV ⁸But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, **while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.**
- ▶ Revelations 2:4 TPT ⁴But **I have this against you:** you have abandoned the passionate love you had for me at the beginning.

Reconnect With The Word Who Sustains Us

► John 6:63-65 NKJV

⁶³ It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. **The words that I speak to you are spirit, and *they* are life.**

⁶⁴ But there are some of you who do not believe.” For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who would betray Him.

⁶⁵ And He said, “Therefore I have said to you that no one can come to Me unless it has been granted to him by My Father.”

Reconnect With The Word - Perfect Theology

▶ Reset your theology to conform to the life of Christ

▶ John 6:68-70 NKJV

⁶⁸ But Simon Peter answered Him, “Lord, to whom shall we go? **You have the words of eternal life.**

⁶⁹ Also we have come to believe and know that You are **the Christ, the Son of the living God.**”

⁷⁰ Jesus answered them, “Did I not choose you, the twelve, and one of you is a devil?”

Reconnect With The Word – It's Heart Relationship

▶ John 5:39-40 TPT

³⁹ “You are busy analyzing the Scriptures, poring over them hoping to gain eternal life. **Everything you read points to me,**

⁴⁰ **yet you still refuse to come to me** so I can give you the life you're looking for—eternal life!

Reconnect With The Word – It's not Head Relationship

▶ John 5:51-52, 66-67 NKJV

⁵¹ I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world.”

⁵² The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, “How can this Man give us *His* flesh to eat?”

⁶⁶ From that *time* many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more.

⁶⁷ Then Jesus said to the twelve, “Do you also want to go away?”

Reconnect With The Word – Do not forget the Lord

► Deuteronomy 8:11-14, 15-17 NLT

¹¹ “But that is the time to be careful! Beware that **in your plenty you do not forget the LORD** your God and disobey his commands, regulations, and decrees that I am giving you today.

¹² For when you have **become full and prosperous** and have **built fine homes** to live in,

¹³ and when your **flocks and herds have become very large** and **your silver and gold have multiplied along with everything else**, be careful!

¹⁴ **Do not become proud** at that time **and forget the LORD your God**, who rescued you from slavery in the land of Egypt.

Thy Kingdom Come

Reconnect With The Word – Do not forget the Lord

▶ Deuteronomy 8:11-14, **15-17 NLT**

¹⁵ **Do not forget** that he led you through the great and terrifying wilderness with its poisonous snakes and scorpions, where it was so hot and dry. He gave you water from the rock!

¹⁶ He fed you with manna in the wilderness, a food unknown to your ancestors. He did this to humble you and test you for your own good.

¹⁷ He did all this so you would never say to yourself, **'I have achieved this wealth with my own strength and energy.'**

Thy Kingdom Come

Reconnect With The Word – Endure The Whole Counsel

▶ 2 Timothy 3:15-17 VOICE

¹⁵ because since childhood you have known the holy Scriptures, **which enable you to be wise** *and lead* to salvation through faith in Jesus the Anointed.

¹⁶ All of Scripture is God-breathed; *in its inspired voice, we hear* useful **teaching, rebuke, correction, instruction, and training** for a life that is right

¹⁷ so that God's people may be **up to the task ahead** and **have all they need to accomplish every good work.**

Thy Kingdom Come

Reconnect With The Word – Endure The Whole Counsel

- ▶ **Teaching** – to communicate to another the knowledge of that of which he was before ignorant.
- ▶ **Rebuke** – stern reprimand or scold with intent to correct a fault.
- ▶ **Correction** – make right or rectify or bring to the standard of truth.
- ▶ **Instruction** – to inform the mind of knowledge that it was destitute of.
- ▶ **Training** – investing in everything that pertains to the proper development of wisdom, stature, favor with God, and favor with man.

Reconnect With The Word – Master Archer Journey

▶ Psalm 105:19-21 TPT

¹⁹ God's promise to Joseph purged his character until it was time for his dreams to come true.

²⁰ Eventually, the king of Egypt sent for him, setting him free at last.

²¹ Then Joseph was put in charge of everything under the king; he became the master of the palace over all the royal possessions.
